

Town of Pollock
Town Council Meeting Minutes
August 1, 2022

The Mayor & Town Council met on said date in a Regular Session at 6 P.M. in the Pollock Municipal Building Council Room, Pollock, La.

The following members were present: Mayor Douglas Beavers, Councilwoman Dee Thorne, Councilwoman Kasandra Hooter, and Councilman Sheldon Smith. The following members were absent: Councilwoman Misty Kinn and Councilwoman Cindy Dickey.

Mayor Beavers called the meeting to order. Councilman Smith led the Lord's Prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilwoman Hooter.
