Town Council Meeting Minutes  
December 4, 2023

The Town Council met on said date in a Regular Session at 6 P.M. in the Pollock Municipal Building Council Room, Pollock, La.

The following members were present: Councilwoman Kayden Carte, Councilwoman Kassandra Hooter, Councilwoman Dee Thorne, Councilman Sheldon Smith, and Councilman Alan Williams.

Mayor Beavers called the meeting to order.

Roll call vote: Yeas 5, Nays 0, Absent 0, Abstain 0. Motion carried.

Chief Chris Paul was present, and the police department report was reviewed. The chief informed the council that his department had a vehicle that was surplus to the department and no longer needed.

Motion by Councilman Williams, seconded by Councilwoman Thorne to declare a vehicle as surplus. Roll call vote: Yeas 5, Nays 0, Absent 0, Abstain 0. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilwoman Hooter, seconded by Councilman Smith to move January meeting to January 8<sup>th</sup> due to the holiday.
